Trauma courses: a proven framework that delivers change

As a result of these courses your empathy for the child will strengthen significantly which will enable you to better understand their individual needs and, as a result, appreciate what you are able to do to improve the life chances of all children in your setting.



Trauma Level 1

Through the course you will develop a more detailed understanding of the impact of Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs) on the life of a child beginning right at the start of a child's life, in Utero.

Trauma Level 2

Built on Trauma Level 1, the course will include more specialised content linked to understanding brain development and the long term impact ACEs can have on a child or young person's life, if not addressed.


Improving outcomes for children

Behaviour management using VR
